**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court

An Act relative to improved medication adherence.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1: Sections 24B1/2 of Chapter 112 of the Acts of 2012 is hereby amended by
2 inserting new paragraph at the end of subsection (e) the following new section:-

3 (f) A pharmacist in the retail setting, who has a collaborative practice agreement with a
4 supervising physician, may administer injectable drugs and biological products that have been
5 ordered by the supervising physician.
