By Mr. Brownsberger, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1117) of William N. Brownsberger for legislation relative to bicycle safety and fluorescent clothing. Public Health.

### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act relative to bicycle safety.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 11B of chapter 85 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended in the second paragraph, clause (iii) by striking out, in line 36:- "16 years of
- 3 age or younger" and further amended by adding at the end thereof, the following new
- 4 paragraph:-
- 5 The Department of Public Health, or other appropriate state agency, shall pursue means
- 6 by which to encourage bicycle operators to wear highly-visible waist-up clothing while
- 7 bicycling. Such clothing should be fluorescent with reflective areas for visibility both during
- 8 daylight and darkness, as consistent with the American National Standards Institute 107-1999
- 9 Class II conspicuity standard.
