- 5 "BPA", the chemical bisphenol A.
- 6 "Person", a natural person, individual, business, corporation, unincorporated association,
- 7 firm, partnership, joint venture or other organization, entity or group of individuals.
- 8 (b) No person shall use thermal paper containing BPA as a receipt of purchase for any9 sale.
- (c) The commissioner of public health shall promulgate rules and regulations as the
 commissioner considers necessary to implement this section.

12 SECTION 2. Section 1 shall take effect one year immediately subsequent to passage.
