An Act expanding access to work release.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 49 of chapter 127 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, beginning in line 3, the words "who has
- 3 served such a portion of his sentence or sentences that he would be eligible for parole within
- 4 eighteen months".
- 5 SECTION 2. Section 49 of chapter 127 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby
- 6 amended by inserting after the word "facility" in line 18 the following sentence:-
- 7 Inmates serving the mandatory term for a violation of section 32, 32A, 32B, 32E, or 32J
- 8 of chapter 94C or section 18, 18C, or 43 of chapter 265 or section 25, 27A, or 28 of chapter 266
- 9 or section 39 of chapter 268 or section 10, 10E, 10F, or 10G of chapter 269 may be permitted to
- participate in programs established under section forty-eight outside a correctional facility.
