An Act establishing the fair share pension act.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Paragraph (b1/2) of subdivision (1) of section 22 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as  
2   appearing in the 2014 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting in line 99 after the word  
3   “dollars.” the following:- For any member of any system accepting the provisions of this  
4   paragraph who entered the service of the commonwealth or a political subdivision thereof on or  
5   after January 1, 2015, the treasurer or other disbursing officer in charge of payroll in any  
6   governmental unit to which a system pertains, shall withhold on each pay day, in addition to the  
7   amounts withheld pursuant to paragraph (b), and the amount withheld pursuant to the preceding  
8   sentence, an additional 28 per cent of such member’s regular compensation over \$100,000.
