An Act relative to the retirement of Mr. John Agnew.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the contrary, John  
2 Agnew, who is scheduled to retire on July 1, 2015 and receive a retirement allowance in  
3 accordance with the terms of Option (C) of Section 12 of Chapter 32 of the General Laws to be  
4 calculated based on the mortality table adopted pursuant to Section 336 of Chapter 149 of the  
5 Acts of 2004, shall be entitled to a recalculation of his retirement allowance based on a  
6 retirement date of March 1, 2015. For purposes of this act, the state teachers' and state  
7 employees' retirement systems shall be deemed to have accepted the provisions of this act.
