**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court
(2015-2016)**

An Act to define surplus for retirement systems.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the definition of “State police surgeon” in
3 line 528, the following definition:-

4 “Surplus”, any monies in the annuity savings fund of any system, the pension fund of any
5 system, in the pension reserve fund of any system in the PRIT fund, in the expense fund of any
6 system and in the special fund for military service, whether from the regular deductions of
7 members, amounts appropriated by any governmental unit, interest or profits earned by monies
8 in all funds shall be held in contractual trust for the exclusive benefit of the members of each
9 retirement system and any amounts in surplus over the requirements to fund fully each system
10 shall be held in trust for the benefit of the members of each system.
