# The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Audrey Graham Smith, an employee of the Executive Office of Health and Human Services.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the executive office of health
2	and human services shall establish a sick leave bank for Audrey Graham Smith, an employee of
3	the executive office, to care for her mother and sister. Any employee of the executive office may
4	voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by
5	Audrey Graham Smith. Whenever Audrey Graham Smith terminates employment with the
6	executive office or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick leave
7	bank shall be transferred to the extended illness leave bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be
8	used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitated the establishment of the
9	sick leave bank as determined by the executive office.
