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In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court  
(2015-2016)  
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An Act relative to pension fund performance and accountability.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1. Section 23 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014  
2   Official Edition, is hereby amended in subsection (f) by inserting after the word “board.” the  
3   following words:- “The PRIM board shall approve all salary adjustments and bonus awards of  
4   the executive director. Any salary increase or bonus award of the executive director must receive  
5   unanimous approval of the PRIM board.”
