An Act further regulating employee benefits.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 100A of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the words, “section 5 of chapter 15A”, in
3 line 18, the following words:-

4 “an employee of the Massachusetts Department of Transportation who was killed in the
5 line of duty or sustained injuries that were the direct and proximate cause of his death while
6 working on construction on the state highway system, as defined in section 1 of chapter 6C,”

7 SECTION 2. Said section 100A of said chapter 32, as so appearing, is hereby amended
8 by inserting after section (h) the following new section:-

9 (i) This section shall apply in the case of the death of an employee of the Massachusetts
10 Department of Transportation employee occurring on or after September 14, 2010.
