An Act protecting volunteer law enforcement.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 89E of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, in line 9, after the figure “152,” the following
3 words:- “or an auxiliary, intermittent, special, part-time or reserve police officer or volunteer
4 deputy sheriff,”

5 SECTION 2. Section 89E of said chapter 32, as so appearing, is hereby further amended,
6 in subsection (d) of clause 3, by inserting, in line 70, after the word “officer”, the following
7 words:- “or volunteer deputy sheriff”
