An Act protecting the rights of custodial and other non-teaching employees of school districts.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 59B of chapter 71 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012 Official Edition,  
2   is hereby amended by inserting after the word "chapter", in lines 13 and 14, the following  
3   words:- ; provided, however, that in case of custodial, maintenance and other non-teaching  
4   positions, the hiring, promotion and termination of such employees shall be conducted in  
5   accordance with chapter 31 if such positions are classified as civil service positions or in  
6   accordance with any governing collective bargaining agreement.
