In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court
(2015-2016)

An Act to reduce the costs for adoption.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 6 of chapter 62 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014 Official Edition, is
2 hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following new subsection:

3 (q) There is hereby established a credit for licensed Massachusetts attorneys who provide
4 pro bono legal services in at least one adoption per year. Each adoption case shall entitle said
5 attorney to a \$500 credit and shall be limited to no more than \$2500 in each tax year.
