An Act increasing restaurant competitiveness.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter 64H of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014  
2   Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “except”, in line 5, the following  
3   words:-

4           “the excise imposed on upon the sale of restaurant meals at the rate of 5 per cent and”

5           SECTION 2. Section 2 of chapter 64L of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby  
6   amended by striking the words “.75 per cent”, in line 4, and inserting in place thereof the  
7   following words:- “1 per cent”.
