An Act increasing restaurant competitiveness.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter 64H of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "except", in line 5, the following
- 3 words:-
- 4 "the excise imposed on upon the sale of restaurant meals at the rate of 5 per cent and"
- 5 SECTION 2. Section 2 of chapter 64L of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby
- 6 amended by striking the words ".75 per cent", in line 4, and inserting in place thereof the
- 7 following words:- "1 per cent".
