Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1 of Chapter 60A of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking the figure
- 2 “10%” after the words “in the fifth and succeeding years” and inserting the word “none”.
