An Act further defining gas fitting under the regulation of plumbing.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 142 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out lines 18-25 and inserting in place thereof the  
3 following:-

4           "Gas fitting", any work which includes the installation, alteration, and replacement of a  
5 piping system beyond the gas meter outlet or regulator through which is conveyed or intended to  
6 be conveyed radon gas or fuel gas of any kind, including methane gas, for power, refrigeration,  
7 heating or illuminating purposes including the connection therewith and testing of gas fixtures,  
8 ranges, refrigerators, stoves, water heaters, house heating boilers, and any other gas using  
9 appliances, and the maintenance in good and safe condition of said systems, and the making of  
10 necessary repairs and changes.
