An Act relative to Public Safety Memorials.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1           Notwithstanding any General or Special Law to the contrary, the site of the
- 2   Massachusetts Law Enforcement Memorial and the Massachusetts Fallen Firefighters Memorial
- 3   at the Massachusetts State House shall remain open to the public seven days a week during times
- 4   when the Department of Conservation and Recreation Rangers are on duty.
