Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 2 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following section:-
- 2 Section 61. The song, “Roadrunner”, words and music by Jonathan Richman, as recorded
- 3 by Jonathan Richman and The Modern Lovers shall be the official rock song of the
