An Act    An Act relative to the prohibition of the use of state funds.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1            SECTION 1. Section 29J of said chapter 29, as appearing in the 2012 Official Edition, is  
2 hereby amended by adding the following sentence:- As used in this section, “state agency”  
3 includes an institution of public higher education or an association of the trustees of such  
4 institutions, and “state funds” includes all funds that state agencies and authorities are authorized  
5 to receive and expend by virtue of the powers granted to them under their enabling statutes,  
6 including trust funds under the control of such institutions.”
