An Act relative to the Commonwealth’s direct debt.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1: Section 60A of chapter 29 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended in paragraph two by striking the number “1.05” and inserting  
3 in place thereof the following number:- “1.00”

4           SECTION 2: The provisions of this act shall expire five years from the date of its  
5 passage, unless otherwise extended, modified or terminated.
