In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act relative to hearses.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the definition of "hands-free mobile
- 3 telephone" the following new definition"-
- 4 "Hearse", any motor vehicle or object on wheels, having motive power of its own, or
- 5 which is drawn by, or used in combination with a motor vehicle, that is regularly used in the
- 6 course of business of the transportation of the deceased, though that business need not be
- 7 conducted by a licensed funeral director or embalmer.
- 8 SECTION 2. The Massachusetts Board of Registration of Funeral Directors and
- 9 Embalmers is hereby directed to promulgate regulations to accommodate the inclusion of the
- definition of "hearse" referenced in section 1 of chapter 90 of the General Laws.
