An Act relative to license renewal fees for Massachusetts veterans.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 33 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014 Official Edition,  
2   is hereby amended by inserting in line 146, at the end of clause 21 the following sentence:-

3           No fee shall be collected for a license or renewal thereof if the applicant is a veteran of  
4   the armed forces as defined by clause 43 of section 7 of chapter 4. The registrar shall annually  
5   report to the secretary of veterans services the number of individuals qualifying under this  
6   section.
