By Mr. Downing, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1927) of Benjamin B. Downing and Paul W. Mark (by vote of the town) for legislation to authorize the town of Dalton to grant an additional license for the sale of all alcoholic beverages not to be drunk on the premises. An Act authorizing the town of Dalton to grant an additional license for the sale of all alcoholic beverages not to be drunk on the premises.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding section 17 of chapter 138 of the General Laws, the
2 licensing authority of the town of Dalton may grant 1 additional license for the sale of all
3 alcoholic beverages not to be drunk on the premises under section 15 of said chapter 138 to
4 Mazvar Inc. d/b/a Greenridge Variety & Convenience, located at 1086 South Street. The license
5 shall be subject to all of said chapter 138 except said section 17.

6 The licensing authority shall not approve the transfer of the license to any other location
7 but it may grant the license to a new applicant at the same location if the applicant files with the
8 licensing authority a letter from the department of revenue indicating that the license is in good
9 standing with the department and that all applicable taxes have been paid.

10 If the license granted pursuant to this act is cancelled, revoked or no longer in use, it shall
11 be returned physically with all of the legal rights, privileges and restrictions pertaining thereto to

12 the licensing authority and the licensing authority may then grant the license to a new applicant
13 at the same location under the same conditions specified in this act.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
