An Act authorizing the town of Topsfield to grant additional licenses for the sale of wines and malt beverages not to be drunk on the premises.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding section 17 of chapter 138 of the General Laws, the  
2   licensing authority of the town of Topsfield shall be authorized to grant an additional two  
3   licenses for the sale of wines and malt beverages not to be drunk on the premises under section  
4   15 of said chapter 138; provided however, that the selling of wines and malt beverages shall be  
5   incidental to the sale of food and other products. The licenses shall be subject to all chapter 138  
6   except section 17 of said chapter.

7           SECTION 2. The licenses granted under this Act, if revoked or no longer in use, shall be  
8   returned physically, with all of the legal rights and privileges pertaining thereto, to the licensing  
9   authority.

10          SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its passage.
