An Act creating uniform beach warnings.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	Chapter 91 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following section:-
2	Section 64. (a) The department of conservation and recreation shall create a state uniform
3	beach warning and safety flag program to be used at all public coastal beaches maintained and
4	guarded by the department. The program shall provide for a uniform size, shape, color and
5	definition for each warning and safety flag deemed necessary by the department.
6	(b) A city or town having jurisdiction over a public beach along the coast may utilize at
7	such beach the state uniform beach warning and safety flag program created by the department
8	of conservation and recreation.
