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An Act relative to the spinal cord injury trust fund.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Subsection (a) of section 59A of chapter 10 of the General Laws, as
2 appearing in the 2014 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 7 and 8, the
3 words “5 or more moving violations or surchargeable offenses” and inserting in place thereof the
4 following words:- “3 surchargeable events within any 2 year period or as a result of receiving 7
5 surchargeable events ”.
