**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court
(2015-2016)**

An Act authorizing the town of Andover school district to convey a certain parcel of land.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of Chapter 30B of the General Laws or any
2 other general or special law to the contrary, the Andover school district is hereby authorized to
3 convey a certain parcel of land which was acquired for school purposes to the Town of Andover
4 for general municipal purposes, including but not limited to school and town administrative
5 offices under the care, custody and control of the Board of Selectmen. Said parcel was conveyed
6 to the Town of Andover in a 1923 deed from the American Woolen Company for the use of
7 school purposes. Said parcel is shown in a plan of land entitled "Plan of Land Conveyed by the
8 American Woolen Co. to the Town of Andover," listed in Book 487, Page 600 at the Northern
9 Essex Registry of Deeds.

10 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
