An Act authorizing the town of Raynham to grant an additional license for the sale of all alcoholic beverages to be drunk on the premises.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding section 17 of chapter 138 of the General Laws, the  
2           licensing authority of the town of Raynham may grant 1 additional license for the sale of all  
3           alcoholic beverages to be drunk on the premises pursuant to section 12 of said chapter 138 to 2  
4           Jerks BBQ, Limited Partnership d/b/a 2 Jerks BBQ Kitchen & Bar at 701 Broadway street. This  
5           license shall be subject to all of said chapter 138 except said section 17.

6           The licensing authority shall not approve the transfer of the license granted pursuant to  
7           this act to any other location but it may grant such license to a new applicant at the same location  
8           if the applicant files with the licensing authority a letter from the department of revenue and a  
9           letter from the department of unemployment assistance indicating that the license is in good  
10          standing with those departments and that all applicable taxes, fees and contributions have been  
11          paid

12           If a license granted pursuant to this act is cancelled, revoked or no longer in use, it shall  
13 be returned physically, with all of the legal rights, privileges, and restrictions pertaining thereto,  
14 to the licensing authority and the licensing authority may then grant the license to a new  
15 applicant at the same location under the same conditions as specified in this act.

16           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
