An Act relative to liquor licenses within the town of Salisbury.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. (a) Notwithstanding the provisions of sections 17 and 17A of Chapter 138  
2 of the General Laws, the licensing authority of the Town of Salisbury is hereby granted five  
3 additional annual licenses for the sale of all alcoholic beverages to be drunk on the premises  
4 pursuant of section 12 of said Chapter 138.

5           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
