In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act authorizing the town of Hubbardston to convey a certain parcel of land.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding chapter 30B of the General Laws, but subject to
- 2 paragraphs (a), (b) and (g) of section 16 of chapter 30B, the town of Hubbardston may convey a
- 3 certain parcel of land, containing 5.09 acres, more or less, located on Ragged Hill Road, shown
- 4 as assessors map 2, lot 33, and described in a deed recorded with the Worcester district registry
- of deeds in book 4420, page 244, currently under the care, custody and control of the Board of
- 6 Selectmen, in exchange for a parcel of land, containing 4.82 acres, more or less, located on
- 7 Gardner Road, shown as assessors map 5C, lot 125, and described in a deed recorded with the
- 8 Worcester district registry of deeds in book 42669, page 1, said parcel to be used for general
- 9 municipal purposes.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
