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**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court  
(2015-2016)**  
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An Act relative to local public housing authorities access to the dental insurance plan managed by the group insurance commission.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1           Section 1. Notwithstanding Chapter 32A of the General Laws, the Group Insurance
- 2           Commission shall provide dental insurance benefits to employees of a housing or redevelopment
- 3           authority upon a vote by its governing body.
