An Act relative to partition fences.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 3 of chapter 49 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014 Official Edition, is  
2 hereby amended by inserting, at the end thereof, the following new paragraph:-

3           “An occupant who keeps livestock or poultry within such an enclosure shall be  
4 responsible for the full cost of maintenance of partition fences if the adjoining occupant does not  
5 keep livestock or poultry, unless both occupants otherwise agree”.
