An Act relative to early education funding.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 64 of chapter 23K of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012 Official Edition,
2 is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following words:- ; and provided further,
3 that 32.5 per cent of the funds shall be appropriated for the purposes of early education to
4 supplement, not offset, any reduction in the general appropriation act from previous fiscal year.
