An Act protecting the rights of probationers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Section 87A of Chapter 276, as it appears in the 2014 Edition of the
2	General Laws, is hereby amended by adding the following language after the word "person" in
3	line 23:-
4	"No person placed on probation shall be deemed to have violated a condition of his or her

5 probation on the basis of his or her possession or use of a controlled substance as prescribed to

6 that person by a health professional registered to prescribe a controlled substance pursuant to

7 Chapter 94C, acting within the lawful scope of his or her practice."
