#### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act authorizing the city known as the town of Randolph to designate a check-off on its tax bills.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. The town of Randolph may, subject to the approval of the commissioner of
- 2 revenue, designate a place on its municipal tax bills, or the motor vehicle excise tax bills, or mail
- 3 with such tax bills a separate form whereby taxpayers of the town can voluntarily check off,
- 4 donate and pledge an amount of money which shall increase the amount already due and which
- 5 shall be paid over to the Randolph Military Services Committee for the support of Randolph
- 6 veterans and dependents in need, and to promote the recognition and observance of patriotic
- 7 holidays.
- 8 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
