An Act authorizing the city known as the town of Randolph to designate a check-off on its tax bills.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. The town of Randolph may, subject to the approval of the commissioner of  
2 revenue, designate a place on its municipal tax bills, or the motor vehicle excise tax bills, or mail  
3 with such tax bills a separate form whereby taxpayers of the town can voluntarily check off,  
4 donate and pledge an amount of money which shall increase the amount already due and which  
5 shall be paid over to the Randolph Military Services Committee for the support of Randolph  
6 veterans and dependents in need, and to promote the recognition and observance of patriotic  
7 holidays.

8           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
