In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act relative to the towing away and storage of motor vehicles.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. An operator of a state-owned park and ride facility may cause the removal
 and storage of a motor vehicle that has been left unattended within a state-owned park and ride
- 3 facility for more than 21 days.
- 4 SECTION 2. The Massachusetts Department of Transportation shall promulgate rules
- 5 and regulations necessary to implement this act.
- 6 SECTION 3. Nothing in this act shall interfere with an existing contract or lease.
