An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Richard Hasbrouck, an employee of the Department of Correction.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the  
2 Department of Correction shall establish a sick leave bank for Richard Hasbrouck, an employee  
3 of the department. Any employee of the department may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick,  
4 personal, or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Richard Hasbrouck. Whenever  
5 Richard Hasbrouck terminates employment with the department or requests to dissolve the sick  
6 leave bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the extended illness  
7 leave bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or  
8 disability that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the  
9 department.
