An Act exempting the police department in the town of Burlington from the civil service law..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1	SECTION 1. The positions within the Burlington Police Department shall be exempt
2	from Chapter 31 of the General Laws.

- 3 SECTION 2. Section 1 shall not impair the civil service status of a person holding a civil
- 4 service position in the town of Burlington on the effect date of this act.
- 5 SECTION 3. This section shall take effect upon its passage.
