An Act including transitory student enrollment in the calculation of aid under Chapter 70.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 70, Section 2 of the General Laws as appearing in the 2008 Official  
2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting at line 270, at the end of the definition of “Foundation  
3 miscellaneous expenses”, the following: (d) Plus an adequate amount of money multiplied by the  
4 transitory student enrollment.

5           SECTION 2. Said Chapter 70, Section 2, as so appearing, is hereby further amended by  
6 adding the following definition after “Total foundation staff”

7           “Transitory student enrollment,” in any fiscal year, the average of the three previous  
8 fiscal years of the number of students reported to enter the school district after October 1 of said  
9 year.
