In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act increasing accountability of DESE contracts.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 15 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following subsection:-
- 3 1U. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, neither the
- 4 Commissioner nor any designee shall enter into any contract for the development or submission
- of any application for funding from the federal government of the United States unless and until
- 6 the contract is approved by a vote of the board following written notice to the board of the
- 7 contents of the contract and a fair opportunity for deliberation on the approval or disapproval of
- 8 such contract.
