**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court
(2015-2016)**

An Act regarding home care services.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 4A of Chapter 19A of the General Laws as appearing in the 2012 edition is
2 hereby amended by striking out the following words: “The department shall establish a sliding
3 fee scale to provide home care services for certain persons whose income exceeds the limits
4 established under Title XX of the Social Security Act,” and inserting in place thereof the
5 following words:- The department shall establish income eligibility to provide home care
6 services for certain persons whose income does not exceed three hundred percent of the federal
7 poverty level, and a sliding fee scale for certain persons receiving home care services whose
8 income exceeds the limits established pursuant to the provisions of section 9 of chapter one
9 hundred and eighteen E.
