In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act regarding Medicaid eligibility for seniors.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 25 of chapter 118E of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 striking out subsection (1) in its entirety and replacing it with the following new subsection:-
- 3 (1) Monthly income in an amount not exceeding the level equivalent of 135% of the
- 4 federal poverty level;
- 5 SECTION 2. Section 25 of chapter 118E of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 6 inserting after subsection (5) the following:
- 7 (6) resources in an amount determined annually in accordance with 42 U.S.C. §1395w-
- 8 114(a)(3), the criteria used for a Medicare Part D low- income subsidy for individuals with
- 9 income up to 150 percent of the federal poverty level.
- The division shall file for any necessary waiver, amend its state plan to the extent
- required by law and promulgate regulations to implement said resource exemption.
