In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act clarifying municipal authority regarding cash sureties and foreclosures.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 127I of chapter 111 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012

2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:-

3 Nothing in this chapter shall be read to preempt any municipal law requiring a cash

4 surety for a property identified as vacant or controlled by a foreclosing entity.

5 SECTION 2. Chapter 244, as so appearing, is hereby amended by inserting after section

6 40 the following section:-

- 7 Section 41. Except where explicitly denied by the General Laws, municipalities shall
- 8 have authority to enact laws for the purpose of minimizing foreclosures, ensuring the safety and
- 9 security of residents, and ensuring the upkeep of vacant properties and those in foreclosure.
