## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act relative to integrated behavioral health care.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 6E of chapter 40J of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out in lines 14-16 the sentence, "Amounts
- 3 credited to the fund shall be expended or applied only with the approval of the executive director
- 4 of the corporation upon consultation with the health information technology council established
- 5 under section 2 of chapter 118I of the General Laws." and inserting in place thereof the
- 6 following new sentence:- "Amounts credited to the fund shall be expended or applied only with
- 7 the approval of the executive director of the health policy commission established under section
- 8 2(b) of chapter 6D of the General Laws."
