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## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

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In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court  
(2015-2016)  
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An Act to ensure continued health insurance coverage for children.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 9A of Chapter 118E of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012 official  
2           edition is hereby amended by inserting the following paragraph:-

3           (17) The executive office of health and human services shall provide coverage to eligible  
4           children and adolescents from birth to age 18 inclusive who meet the eligibility requirements of  
5           clause (c) of sub-section 2 of this section, and to pregnant women under section 10E, regardless  
6           of the availability of federal funding under Title XXI of the Social Security Act; provided  
7           however that the executive office shall seek to maximize federal financial participation in the  
8           program through the demonstration project under Title XIX of the Social Security Act, or under  
9           the authority of Title XXI, if funding is available.
