An Act relative to increasing access to psychological services.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1           SECTION 1. Chapter 118E of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012 Official  
2   Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after section 10 H the following new section:-
- 3           Section 10 I. The division shall cover treatment, diagnostic evaluations, assessment,  
4   testing and supervisory services provided by licensed psychologists.
