## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act ensuring access to necessary hospital services.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 51 of chapter 111 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:-
- 3 Any licensed hospital that provides cardiac catheterization services, with an annual
- 4 patient volume of at least 300 diagnostic procedures each calendar year by multiple physicians,
- 5 or 150 procedures each calendar year by a sole physician, shall be deemed to comply with the
- 6 volume requirements set forth by the Department and shall not be subject to any enforcement
- 7 action by the Department solely due to volume levels.
