An Act relative to in-state tuition retention for UMMS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Chapter 75 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012 Official Edition, is hereby  
2 amended by inserting after section 1A the following:

3           Section 1B: Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the University of  
4 Massachusetts Medical School shall retain all in-state tuition and mandatory general attendance  
5 fees charged to students, provided that general attendance fees shall not include charges for  
6 health insurance.
